The **LEADER IN TRAINING** (LIT) camper program is a great step for getting involved at camp. Maple Springs is looking for youth ages 14-16 who want to serve with others their age. The LIT program will challenge you and may also be one of the most powerful experiences in your life. After completing the two year LIT program, and if you've turned 16, you will be given preference for summer volunteer positions.

Work Experience

LITs work hard during the sessions cleaning dishes, toilets, sinks, floors, and completing everyday camp tasks. You will be doing a lot of work but in a fun atmosphere. Throughout the day there will be time for things like swimming, hiking, riflery, spontaneous fun, laughter, games, and building new friendships.

Spiritual Growth

Throughout your session you will be spiritually challenged and stretched through building relationships. There will be time for bible study, discussion, worship, and prayer. This will be a great time for learning more about God's heart. Come expecting to stretched and challenged.

Skill Development

Junior LITs

The Junior LIT program is for first time LITs and focuses on learning to serve. You will do dishes, lead activities with campers, clean bathrooms, do general camp cleaning, and attend sessions based on learning to serve humbly.

Senior LITs

The Senior LIT program is for second year LITs! It includes some of the same components as the Junior LIT program, but with a focus on leading kids! You will be paired with a camper cabin for a week. As a Senior LIT you will have the opportunity to serve through work, build relationships with campers, and being a great example to other LITs. This program is a great experience for learning what it's like to be a cabin leader, and for gaining knowledge, skills and leadership to use in a cabin and in life! Accepted Sr. LITs must be mature leaders and awesome role models.

Things to Note!

- You can apply either online or by sending in a paper copy of your application (found on the webpage)
- LITs must give contact information for two references.
- Drop off is 1:00 pm on the first day of the camp, and Pick-up is 1:00 pm on the last day of the camp (excluding mini camps)
- LITs are only permitted to apply for ONE summer session, but as many non-summer sessions as you want!
- LITs MUST go home on the weekend, they are not permitted to stay at the camp.
